Sen. Dayton introduced and explained the bill.

**MOTION:** Sen. Dayton moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, Lines 31 through 32:

- 31            (b) the policy under Subsection (1)(a) is    :
- (i)     posted and publicly available on the {     ~~Internet~~
- 32 and available at the law enforcement agency's main office for public inspection and  
copying }     appropriate city, county, or state website    ; or
- (ii)     posted on the Utah Public Notice Website created in Section  
63F-1-701 if the law enforcement agency does not have access to a website  
under Subsection (1)(b)(i).

The motion passed with Sen. Jenkins voting in opposition.
