H.B. 399 Physician and Osteopathic Licensing Amendments (Rep. S. Sandstrom)

MOTION: Rep. Webb moved to amend H.B. 399 as follows:

1. *Page 5, Lines 133 through 134:*

133 (5) The division may not require a medical specialty certification or
{ ~~board~~ subspecialty certification as a qualification for initial
134 licensure or to maintain licensure .

2. *Page 8, Lines 243 through 244:*

243 (5) The division may not require a medical specialty certification or

244 { ~~board~~ — subspecialty — certification as a qualification for initial
licensure or to maintain licensure —.
